Notes: The federal Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) requires that states test all students in reading and math each year in grades 3-8 and once in high school. A small percentage of students with IEPs may be tested using alternate online assessments to the PARCC called Dynamic Learning Maps (DLM). The DLMs will be administered in the same time window as the PARCC assessments. Some students with IEPs may complete a portfolio assessment in science in lieu of the standardized BCT assessment. Please contact the Director of Special Services for further information. Attainment of passing scores on the PARCC assessments is the preferred path to graduation for high school students. Other pathways, including PSAT/SAT scores, AccuPlacer and ASVAB results, MAY be used to fulfill the NJDOE graduation requirements.
